EEP Mekong Components



- Support to national policy, legislation and institutional framework
- Development of RE, WTE and EE technologies and services (demand driven partnership activities)
- Information and Capacity Building on RE, WTE, EE and energy markets

EEP Mekong Calls for Proposals



- ▶ First call for Proposals: October 15 – December 31, 2009
- ▶ Second call for Proposals: August 2 – October 15, 2010
- ▶ Third call for proposals : January 17– March 11, 2011

Eligible Applicants



- ▶ NGOs
- ▶ Private companies
- ▶ Public institutions
- ▶ Research organisations
- ▶ Academic institutions

To enhance technology transfer, cooperation between donor countries and local project developers is encouraged.

Ineligible Applicants



- ▶ Multilateral Institutions
- ▶ Development Agencies
- ▶ Trust Funds

- ▶ Biomass
- ▶ Bio-fuels

- ▶ Energy Efficiency/Conservation
- ▶ Geothermal

Project activities eligible for funding



- ▶ Pilot Projects
- ▶ Demonstration Projects
- ▶ Pre-feasibility Studies / Feasibility Studies
- ▶ Capacity building / training

Geographical coverage



- ▶ Cambodia
- ▶ Lao PDR
- ▶ Thailand
- ▶ Vietnam
- ▶ Regional (min. 2 Mekong partner countries)

Some exclusion clauses



- ▶ Bio-fuel production for export
- ▶ Hydro power > 10 MW
- ▶ Request for EEP support > EUR 200,000
- ▶ Project completion later than November 30, 2012.

- Project screening
- Project evaluation
- Project pre-selection
- Notification to successful applicants
- Submission of Full Project Proposals (FPPs)
- Final Evaluation of FPPs
- Contracting

The Evaluation Process (1)



Screening for compliance (conducted by RCU)

- **Objectives** of EEP Mekong are met
- Both **Energy and Environment** components are addressed
- **Submission Guidelines** are strictly followed

The Evaluation Process (2)



Screening for relevance (conducted by NCUs)

- to the **objectives** and the **priorities** of the call for proposals;
- to the particular **needs** and **constraints** of the target country/countries or region(s) (including avoidance of duplication and synergy with other on-going initiatives);
- to those involved. Are final **beneficiaries**, **target groups** clearly identified and their needs taken into consideration? Does the proposal address them properly?
